RESERVOIR SUN, A 100% GREENYELLOW SUBSIDIARY, SUPPORTS SAFRAN IN ITS ENERGY TRANSITION AND INAUGURATES A 4.8 MWP SELF-CONSUMPTION PROJECT AT THE NACELLE PRODUCTION SITE



As part of the contract signed with the French group Safran on July 8, 2022, specializing in the aerospace (propulsion, equipment, and interiors), space, and defense sectors, **Reservoir Sun**, a **100%** subsidiary of **GreenYellow** and a **leader in solar self-consumption in France**, has just inaugurated today at the nacelle production site in Gonfreville-l'Orcher, Seine-Maritime. This project is **part of the 8 planned sites in France by 2025**, with a **total capacity of nearly 25 MWp**, primarily deployed in parking shade structures.

This project, with a total capacity of **4.8 MWp for self-consumption**, exclusively dedicated to the **1,500 employees of the site**, equivalent to the **average annual electricity consumption of 1,030 households**, consists of an installation of **12,000 photovoltaic panels in parking shade structures, covering a total area of 24,000 m²**. This installation will cover more than **25% of the site's electricity needs**, with an annual production of **4.9 GWh of low-carbon electricity**. This project represents a significant economic and environmental benefit.

Fully financed by Reservoir Sun, this installation is one of the largest self-consumption photovoltaic power plants on an industrial site in France.

A GROUNDBREAKING PARTNERSHIP WITH SAFRAN

Reservoir Sun is collaborating with Safran to support the Group in its energy transition in France. This project, contracted, financed, developed, and built rapidly for a 4.8 MWp solar power plant, is the result of a tender launched by Safran in 2021 for the solarization of its French sites. Safran Nacelles' solar project, operational since August 2023, marks the beginning of a long-term collaboration, with a second project already underway in another parking area at the Gonfreville-L'Orcher site.

For Safran, this collaboration reflects a deep commitment to contemporary environmental and societal challenges, signaling its transition towards renewable energies. By choosing Reservoir Sun as a partner in this initiative, Safran aligns itself with a major player in solar self-consumption, which has become a market leader in France in just 5 years.

"Reservoir Sun is proud to support Safran in its energy transition by providing environmentally-friendly offerings. Our comprehensive installation management aims to assist Safran in reducing its energy consumption while improving its performance," says Mathieu Cambet, Director of Reservoir Sun by GreenYellow.

"Thanks to our collaboration with Reservoir Sun, the installation of the photovoltaic plant at the Gonfreville-L'Orcher site took less than a year, and we already see a performance that meets our expectations. By directly consuming the electricity produced by the photovoltaic plant, we increase our local energy autonomy and take another step in our commitment to reduce our environmental footprint," adds Vincent Caro, President of Safran Nacelles.
