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# RESERVOIR SUN SUPPORTS L'OREAL IN ITS ENERGY TRANSITION AND INAUGURATES A 1,250 KWP SELF-CONSUMPTION PROJECT AT THE CAUDRY SITE





As part of its long-term contract established earlier this year with the L'Oréal factory in Caudry, in the Nord region, Reservoir Sun, a 100% subsidiary of GreenYellow and a leader in solar self-consumption in France, is inaugurating today its first fully self-consumption project.

The project, with a total capacity of **1.2 MWp**, consists of a 1 MWp installation in a parking lot canopy and a 250 kWp ground-mounted solar farm, totaling **3,166 solar panels**. This installation will cover 10% of the site's electricity needs and produce **1.2 GWh of low-carbon electricity annually**, fully consumed by the factory. This amount of electricity is equivalent to what would be needed to power an average of 260 households.

With this project, Reservoir Sun establishes its largest self-consumption solar plant in the Hauts-de-France region.

## A long-term partnership with the L'Oréal factory in Caudry

Reservoir Sun collaborates with L'Oréal and supports the group in its energy transition in France. The project in Caudry is the first of this collaboration, while two other sites have already been established and are operational.
